THE RULES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED

1. It is the sole responsibility of the skip to ensure this entry form is completed, and in the hands of the Lawn Bowls Association of Alberta office prior to the entry deadline date as outlined on each event poster either by fax, e-mail or phone.
2. All contestants must be prepared to produce a current LBAA Membership card prior to play, duly signed by the appropriate Club Director. The cards will be shown to the tournament chairperson or their designate prior to trial ends.
FAILURE TO PRODUCE A PROPER CARD WILL RESULT IN FORFEITURE OF GAME.
3. **No member(s) may enter an LBAA Playdown if they have previously won an LBAA Playdown for the current year.**
4. Each skip shall be held responsible for dress code as in conditions of play, attitude and deportment of each member of the team during said competition. Failure to comply upon notification, and after review by the Tournament Chair or their duly appointed representatives, may result in forfeiture of match to the opposing team.
5. Substitution of Team members shall be permitted prior to the commencement of said tournament, after which Bowls Canada Boulingrin Rules of substitution shall prevail.
6. There will be Shoe, Bowls and Membership Card inspection prior to the start of each event. All bowls must have a valid stamp. The complete stamp must be visible on all bowls inspected.
